Libby Willems To Launch Debut Album 'GOODSIDE' At Neerim South

Tickets are now on sale for the launch of local singer/songwriter, Libby Willems' debut solo album *GOODSIDE* at Algie Hall, Neerim South on Friday 8th September.

GOODSIDE is a rock/pop/country album influenced by the styles of iconic Australian artists such as Deborah Conway, Cold Chisel, Paul Kelly, and The Divinyls, and undeniable international legends like Linda Ronstadt and Creedence Clearwater Revival. Ten original tracks were chosen from a long list of Libby's music to curate an album that excites, stirs, and relaxes the listener across the journey of the album.

Libby has collaborated with experienced producer and musician, Geoff Peterkin, (The Breakers, Johnny Chester and The Lonesome Hearts, Ol' 55, The Hitmen), and multi instrumentalist Andy Colville, (The Breakers, Johnny Chester and The Lonesome Hearts, The Bushwackers), to create *GOODSIDE*.

A local community venue, Algie Hall Neerim South, will host the event. People are invited to book tickets and be part of the atmosphere of launching new Australian music. Under 16s can attend free provided they are with a responsible adult and have booked a ticket.

CDs of *GOODSIDE* are available for purchase on the night. Pre-order when you buy your ticket.

Libby is a popular performer in West Gippsland and you can find her at many of the live music venues in Warragul, Drouin, Neerim South, Noojee, and Willow Grove. In March 2023, Libby performed an original song "One By One" at the International Women's Day event at West Gippsland Arts Centre, drawing praise from the Guest Speaker and musician, Clare Bowditch. More recently, the Victorian Government's Regional Rail Revival project celebrated Libby's catchy song "Ridin' on The Gippsland Line" in a <u>promotional clip for works completed at Traralgon.</u>

You may also know Libby Willems from her musical work with preschoolers at Fiddlesticks Performing Arts, Warragul, or as conductor of community choir Baw Baw Singers.
